THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EC) No 2580/2001 of 27 December 2001 on specific restrictive measures directed against certain persons and entities associated with a view to combating terrorism⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 7 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Annex to Regulation (EC) No 2580/2001 lists the competent authorities to whom information and requests concerning the measures imposed by that Regulation should be sent.
- (2) Slovenia requested that the address details concerning its competent authorities should be amended. Furthermore, the European Commission's address should be updated.
- (3) Annex to Regulation (EC) No 2580/2001 should therefore be updated accordingly,
