ANNEX I

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS FOR VEHICLES EOUIPPED WITH GEAR SHIFT INDICATORS (GSI)

3. Information to be provided

- The manufacturer shall provide the following information to the type-approval 3.1. authority. The information shall be made available in the following two parts:
- the 'formal documentation package' that may be made available to interested parties (a) upon request;
- the 'extended documentation package' that shall remain strictly confidential. (b)
- 3.1.1. The formal documentation package shall contain:
- (a) a description of the complete set of appearances of the GSIs which are fitted on vehicles being part of the vehicle type with regard to GSI, and evidence of their compliance with the requirements of point 1;
- evidence in the form of data or engineering evaluations, for example modelling data, (b) emission or fuel consumption maps, emission tests, which adequately demonstrate that the GSI is effective in providing timely and meaningful shift recommendations to the driver in order to comply with the requirements of point 2;
- an explanation of the purpose, use and functions of the GSI in a 'GSI section' of the (c) user manual accompanying the vehicle.
- 3.1.2. The extended documentation package shall contain the design strategy of the GSI, in particular its functional characteristics.
- Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 5, the extended documentation package 3.1.3. shall remain strictly confidential between the type-approval authority and the manufacturer. It may be kept by the type-approval authority, or, at the discretion of the type-approval authority, may be retained by the manufacturer. In the case the manufacturer retains the documentation package, that package shall be identified and dated by the type-approval authority once reviewed and approved. It shall be made available for inspection by the approval authority at the time of approval or at any time during the validity of the approval.
- 3.2. The manufacturer shall provide an explanation of the purpose, use and functions of the GSI in a 'GSI section' of the user manual accompanying the vehicle.
