### THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EC) No 1234/2007 of 22 October 2007 establishing a common organisation of agricultural markets and on specific provisions for certain agricultural products (Single CMO Regulation)<sup>(1)</sup>, and in particular Articles 113(1)(a) and 121(h) in conjunction with Article 4 thereof,

#### Whereas:

- (1) The Slovenian language version of Regulation (EEC) No 2568/91 as amended by Commission Regulation (EU) No 61/2011<sup>(2)</sup> contains an error, i.e. in Annex XX, point 4.2, the wording "the purity must be checked" is erroneous. Therefore a correction of the Slovenian language version is necessary. The other language versions are not affected.
- (2) Regulation (EEC) No 2568/91 should therefore be corrected accordingly.
- (3) The measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for the Common Organisation of Agricultural Markets,

#### HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Concerns only the Slovenian language version.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the 20th day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
