THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EC) No 881/2002 of 27 May 2002 imposing certain
specific restrictive measures directed against certain persons and entities associated with the Al-
Qaida network,⁽¹⁾ and in particular Article 7(1)(a) and 7a(5) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Annex I to Regulation (EC) No 881/2002 lists the persons, groups and entities covered
by the freezing of funds and economic resources under that Regulation.
- (2) On 27 September 2012 the Sanctions Committee of the United Nations Security Council
decided to remove one natural person from its list of persons, groups and entities to
whom the freezing of funds and economic resources should apply after considering
the de-listing request submitted by this person and the Comprehensive Report of the
Ombudsperson established pursuant to United Nations Security Council Resolution
1904(2009).
- (3) Annex I to Regulation (EC) No 881/2002 should therefore be updated accordingly,
