

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 230/2013 of 14 March 2013
on the withdrawal from the market of certain feed additives belonging to the
group of flavouring and appetising substances (Text with EEA relevance)

Article 2

Transitional measures

1 Existing stocks of the feed additives set out in Part A of the Annex may continue to be placed on the market and used as feed additives belonging to the group ‘flavouring and appetising substances’ until 10 April 2014.

2 Premixtures produced with the additives referred to in paragraph 1 may continue to be placed on the market and used until 10 October 2014.

3 Compound feed and feed materials produced with the additives referred to in paragraph 1 or with the premixtures referred to in paragraph 2 and which have been labelled in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 767/2009 until 10 April 2015 may continue to be placed on the market and used until stocks are exhausted.

4 As regards the feed additives set out in Part B of the Annex, paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 shall apply in respect of the animal species or categories of animal species specified in that Part of the Annex.

Changes to legislation:
