THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Council Directive 2002/53/EC of 13 June 2002 on the common catalogue of varieties of agricultural plant species⁽¹⁾ and in particular Article 9(6) thereof,

Having regard to Council Directive 2002/55/EC of 13 June 2002 on the marketing of vegetable seed⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 9(6) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) As regards certain species, the classes set out in Annex I to Commission Regulation (EC) No 637/2009 of 22 July 2009 establishing implementing rules as to the suitability of the denominations of varieties of agricultural plant species and vegetable species⁽³⁾ should be adapted to take into account changes in international botanical classification. The Community Plant Variety Office already included, in November 2012, those changes in the ‘Guidelines with explanatory notes on Article 63 of Council Regulation (EC) No 2100/94 of 27 July 1994 on Community Plant Variety Rights’.
- (2) Regulation (EC) No 637/2009 should therefore be amended accordingly.
- (3) The measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Standing Committee on Seeds and Propagating Material for Agriculture, Horticulture and Forestry,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Annex I to Regulation (EC) No 637/2009 is amended in accordance with the Annex to this Regulation.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the twentieth day following that of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

ANNEX

Annex I to Regulation (EC) No 637/2009 is amended as follows:

- (1) in Table 1, ‘Classes within a genus’, the rows concerning classes 4.1 and 4.2 are replaced by the following:

| Classes | Scientific names |
|----------------|--|
| ‘Class 4.1 | <i>Solanum tuberosum</i> |
| Class 4.2 | <i>Solanum lycopersicum</i> , rootstocks of tomato and interspecific hybrids |
| Class 4.3 | <i>Solanum melongena</i> |
| Class 4.4 | <i>Solanum other than classes 4.1, 4.2, 4.3</i> ’ |

- (2) in Table 2, ‘Classes encompassing more than one genus’, the rows concerning classes 201 and 203 are replaced by the following:

| Classes | Scientific names |
|----------------|--|
| ‘Class 201 | <i>Secale, Triticum, xTriticosecale</i> |
| Class 203 (*) | <i>Agrostis, Dactylis, Festuca, xFestulolium, Lolium, Phalaris, Phleum and Poa</i> ’ |
