

Regulation (EU) No 952/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 October 2013 laying down the Union Customs Code (recast)

TITLE I

**GENERAL PROVISIONS**

CHAPTER 3

***Currency conversion and time-limits***

*Article 55*

**Periods, dates and time-limits**

1 Unless otherwise provided, where a period, date or time-limit is laid down in the customs legislation, such period shall not be extended or reduced and such date or time-limit shall not be deferred or brought forward.

2 The rules applicable to periods, dates and time-limits set out in Regulation (EEC, Euratom) No 1182/71 of the Council of 3 June 1971 determining the rules applicable to periods, dates and time-limits<sup>(1)</sup> shall apply, except where otherwise provided for in the customs legislation.
