of 14 April 2014

amending Council Regulation (EC) No 329/2007 concerning restrictive measures against the Democratic People's Republic of Korea

THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EC) No 329/2007 of 27 March 2007 concerning restrictive measures against the Democratic People's Republic of Korea⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 13(1)(d) and (e) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Annex IV to Regulation (EC) No 329/2007 lists persons, entities and bodies on the basis of determinations made by the Sanctions Committee of the UN Security Council.
- (2) Annex V to Regulation (EC) No 329/2007 lists persons, entities and bodies who, having been designated by the Council, are covered by the freezing of funds and economic resources under that Regulation.
- (3) On 14 April 2014, on the basis of a determination by the Sanctions Committee, the Council decided⁽²⁾ to amend the information relating to one entity in the list of persons, entities and bodies to whom the freezing of funds and economic resources should apply and delete an entity from Annex IV. Annex IV should therefore be amended accordingly.
- (4) On 14 April 2014, the Council also decided to delete a person listed in Annex V. Annex V should therefore be amended.
- (5) In order to ensure that the measures provided for in this Regulation are effective, this Regulation must enter into force immediately,
