THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 1338/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 December 2008 on Community statistics on public health and health and safety at work⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 9(1) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Annex II to Commission Regulation (EU) No 141/2013⁽²⁾ provides for the minimum effective sample size, calculated on the assumption of simple random sampling.
- (2) It is necessary to adapt Annex II to Regulation (EU) No 141/2013 to take into account the accession of Croatia.
- (3) Regulation (EU) No 141/2013 should therefore be amended accordingly.
- (4) The measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the European Statistical System Committee,
