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The statement 'gluten-free' may only be made where the food as sold to the final consumer contains no more than $20 \mathrm{mg} / \mathrm{kg}$ of gluten.
VERY LOW GLUTEN
The statement 'very low gluten' may only be made where the food, consisting of or containing one or more ingredients made from wheat, rye, barley, oats or their crossbred varieties which have been specially processed to reduce the gluten content, contains no more than $100 \mathrm{mg} / \mathrm{kg}$ of gluten in the food as sold to the final consumer.
