CHAPTER II

SECTION 2

Obligations on the payment service provider of the payee

Article 9

Assessment and reporting

The payment service provider of the payee shall take into account missing or incomplete information on the payer or the payee as a factor when assessing whether a transfer of funds, or any related transaction, is suspicious and whether it is to be reported to the Financial Intelligence Unit (FIU) in accordance with [^{F1}the 2017 Regulations].
