

Regulation (EU) 2016/1036 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2016 on protection against dumped imports from countries not members of the European Union (codification)

Article 22

Final provisions

This Regulation shall not preclude the application of:

- (a) any special rules laid down in agreements concluded between the Union and third countries;
- (b) the Union Regulations in the agricultural sector and Council Regulations (EC) No 1667/2006⁽¹⁾, (EC) No 614/2009⁽²⁾ and (EC) No 1216/2009⁽³⁾. This Regulation shall operate by way of complement to those Regulations and in derogation from any provisions thereof which preclude the application of anti-dumping duties;
- (c) special measures, provided that such action does not run counter to obligations under the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade 1994.
