CHAPTER II

FISHING OPPORTUNITIES

Article 7

Measures on recreational fisheries for cod in subdivisions ICES 22-26

- 1 In recreational fisheries, no more than five specimens of cod may be retained per fisherman per day in ICES subdivisions 22 and 23 and in ICES subdivision 24 within six nautical miles measured from the baselines.
- By way of derogation from paragraph 1, no more than two specimens of cod may be retained per fishermen per day in ICES subdivisions 22 and 23 and in ICES subdivision 24 within six nautical miles measured from the baselines in the period from 1 February to 31 March 2020.
- Recreational fishing for cod shall be prohibited in ICES subdivision 24 beyond six nautical miles measured from the baselines and in ICES subdivisions 25 and 26.
- 4 Paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 are without prejudice to more stringent national measures.
