ENFORCEMENT

Penalty

61 Representations

After section 50K of the Housing Act 1996 insert—

"50L Representations

- (1) A pre-penalty warning must specify a period during which the registered social landlord may make representations to the Welsh Ministers.
- (2) The period must—
 - (a) be a period of at least 28 days, and
 - (b) begin with the date on which the registered social landlord receives the pre-penalty warning.
- (3) Representations may address—
 - (a) whether a penalty should be imposed;
 - (b) the amount of any penalty that may be imposed.
- (4) After the end of the period specified under subsection (1) the Welsh Ministers must—
 - (a) consider any representations made, and
 - (b) decide whether to impose a penalty."
