



Children (Emergency Protection Orders) Act (Northern Ireland) 2007

2007 CHAPTER 3

N.I.

An Act to repeal Article 64(8) of the Children (Northern Ireland) Order 1995. [14th December 2007]

BE IT ENACTED by being passed by the Northern Ireland Assembly and assented to by Her Majesty as follows:

Repeal of Article 64(8) of the Children (Northern Ireland) Order 1995 **N.I.**

1 In the Children (Northern Ireland) Order 1995 (NI 2) paragraph (8) of Article 64 (which prevents an application for the discharge of an emergency protection order being heard by a court within 72 hours of the making of the order) is repealed.

Short title and commencement **N.I.**

2.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Children (Emergency Protection Orders) Act (Northern Ireland) 2007.

(2) This Act shall come into operation on Royal Assent.
