**The Pig Production Development (Amendment)  
(Northern Ireland) Order 1973**

*Laid before Parliament in draft*

*Made* 27th July 1973

*Coming into Operation* 10th August 1973

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 27th day of July 1973

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas a draft of this Order has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 (3) of the Northern Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972 (a), and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

*Title and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Pig Production Development (Amendment) (Northern Ireland) Order 1973 and shall come into operation on the fourteenth day after the day on which it is made.

*Interpretation*

2. The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 (b) shall apply to Articles 1 and 3 as it applies to an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

*Increase in limit on levy payable in respect of pigs sold to the Pigs Marketing Board*

3. The limit imposed by section 4 (1) of the Pig Production Development Act (Northern Ireland) 1964 (c) on the amount of the levy payable under that section in respect of each pig sold to the Pigs Marketing Board shall be increased to twenty pence and accordingly in that section for the words "one shilling" there shall be substituted the words "twenty pence".
