The Appropriation (Northern Ireland) Order 1974

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 25th day of July 1974

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas it has been made to appear to Her Majesty that by reason of urgency this Order requires to be made without a draft having been approved by resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974(a), and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

Title and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Appropriation (Northern Ireland) Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 5th August 1974.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(b) shall apply to Article 1 and the following provisions of this Order as it applies to a Measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

Issue of sum out of Consolidated Fund for service of year ending 31st March 1975

3. There shall be charged on and issued out of the Consolidated Fund, and the Department of Finance may apply towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending 31st March 1975 the sum of three hundred and eighty-eight million, nine hundred and forty-five thousand, eight hundred pounds.

Power for Department of Finance to borrow

4.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), the Department of Finance may borrow on the credit of the aforesaid sum, any sum or sums not exceeding in the whole one hundred and ninety-four million pounds.

(2) Any money so borrowed shall be repaid, with any interest due thereon, out of the Consolidated Fund at any date not later than 31st March 1975.

Appropriation of grants

5.—(1) The sums granted and authorised to be issued by the Consolidated Fund Measure (Northern Ireland) 1974(a) towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of two hundred and sixty-one million, four hundred and thirty-seven thousand pounds, may, notwithstanding the prorogation of the Assembly by the Northern Ireland Assembly (Prorogation) Order 1974(b) without the grants having been appropriated, be so issued.

(2) The sums authorised to be issued out of the Consolidated Fund as mentioned in Article 3 and paragraph (1), amounting in the aggregate, as appears from Schedule (A), to the sum of six hundred and fifty million, three hundred and eighty-two thousand, eight hundred pounds are hereby appropriated for the several services and purposes expressed in Schedule (B).

(3) In addition to the sums authorised to be issued out of the Consolidated Fund as mentioned in Article 3 and paragraph (1)—

(a) the sums, which, under the Appropriation (No. 2) (Northern Ireland) Order 1973(c) and the Appropriation (No. 3) (Northern Ireland) Order 1973(d), were authorised to be applied as appropriations in aid for the year ended 31st March 1974, shall be treated as having been increased or as the case may be, decreased by the sums respectively set forth in columns 3 and 4 of Part I of Schedule (B) in respect of the several services specified in that Part;

(b) there may be applied as appropriations in aid of the grants for the services and purposes specified in Part II of Schedule (B) the sums respectively set forth in the last column of that Part.

(4) This Article shall have effect in relation to any sum issued or appropriated in aid before the commencement of this Order as if this Order had been in force at the time that sum was issued or appropriated.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order authorises the issue of a sum out of the Northern Ireland Consolidated Fund and appropriates that sum, together with sums issued before the commencement of the Order, for specified services in Northern Ireland.
