Treatment of Offenders (Northern Ireland) Order 1980

Title and commencement

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Treatment of Offenders (Northern Ireland) Order 1980 \dots Commencement^{F1} \dots
 - F1 fully exercised by SR 1980/341

Interpretation

- **2.**—(1) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 shall apply to Article 1 and the following provisions of this Order as it applies to a Measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly.
 - (2) In this Order—
- "the appointed day" means the day appointed under Article 1;
- "young offenders centre" has the meaning assigned to it by section 2(a) of the Treatment of Offenders Act (Northern Ireland) 1968.

Abolition of Borstal training

3. No person shall, after the appointed day, be sentenced to Borstal training.

Transitional provisions, amendments and repeals

4.—(1) The transitional provisions set out in Schedule 1 shall have effect.
