# PART III ORIGINAL CIVIL JURISDICTION

Probate Jurisdiction

### Representatives to lodge accounts if required

- 17.—(1) The representatives of a deceased person the value of whose estate does not exceed[F1 £45,000] shall, if so required in writing at any time after the expiration of twelve months from the death of that person, by a legatee, devisee, next-of-kin, heir, creditor or other person interested in the estate, make up and lodge in accordance with county court rules a duly verified account setting forth such particulars of the estate as shall be prescribed; and any representative failing to comply with such a requisition shall be guilty of contempt of court.
- (2) Every such account shall be preserved among the records of the chief clerk and shall, as against the representative signing it, be evidence of the matters therein set forth.
