**The Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 1984**

Repeal of enactments relating to agriculture

**Repeal of Live Stock Breeding Act (Northern Ireland) 1922** **N.I.**

**18.** The Live Stock Breeding Act (Northern Ireland) 1922<sup>F1</sup> (which regulates the keeping of bulls, boars and rams) shall cease to have effect.

**Repeal of Marketing of Poultry Act (Northern Ireland) 1949** **N.I.**

**19.** The Marketing of Poultry Act (Northern Ireland) 1949<sup>F2</sup> (which prescribes quality standards and licensing requirements for the marketing of poultry) shall cease to have effect.

**Licensing of slaughter-houses** **N.I.**

**21.** In section 1 of the Slaughter-houses Act (Northern Ireland) 1953<sup>F4</sup> (licensing of slaughter-houses) subsection (4)(f) (which empowers the Department to refuse a licence if not satisfied that the premises are needed for use as a slaughter-house) shall cease to have effect.

**Repeal of Control of Fertilisers Act (Northern Ireland) 1953** **N.I.**

**22.** The Control of Fertilisers Act (Northern Ireland) Act 1953<sup>F5</sup> (which provides for fertilisers to be sold only by licensed persons) shall cease to have effect.
