**The Nature Conservation and Amenity Lands
(Amendment) (Northern Ireland) Order 1989**

Introductory

Title and commencement **N.I.**

1. This Order may be cited as the Nature Conservation and Amenity Lands (Amendment) (Northern Ireland) Order 1989 and shall come into operation on the expiration of 2 months from the day on which it is made.

Interpretation **N.I.**

2.—(1) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954^{F1} shall apply to Article 1 and the following provisions of this Order as it applies to a Measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

(2) In this Order—

“the Department” means the Department of the Environment;

“the Nature Conservation and Amenity Lands Order” means the Nature Conservation and Amenity Lands (Northern Ireland) Order 1985

^{F2}“statutory provision” has the meaning assigned to it by section 1(*f*) of the Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954;

“transfer date” means the date on which this Order comes into operation;

“transferor” and “transferee” respectively mean, in relation to any functions transferred under this Order, the committee from and the council to which the functions are transferred.
