# 1991 No. 1220

## The Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1991

### PART V

#### ADDITIONAL PLANNING CONTROL

##### Buildings of special architectural or historic interest

##### Temporary listing in urgent cases

<sup>F1</sup>**42B.**—(1) If it appears to the Department to be urgent that a building preservation notice should come into force, it may, instead of serving the notice on the owner and occupier of the building, affix the notice conspicuously to some object on the building.

(2) The affixing of a notice under paragraph (1) shall be treated for all the purposes of Article 42A, this Article, Article 42C and Articles 45 to 47 and Schedule 1 as service of the notice.

(3) A notice which is so affixed must explain that by virtue of being so affixed it is treated as being served for those purposes.
