**The Industrial Tribunals (Northern Ireland) Order 1996**

*Conciliation*

**Conciliation procedure**

**21.**—<sup>F1</sup>(1) Industrial tribunal procedure regulations shall include in relation to industrial tribunal proceedings in the case of which any statutory provision makes provision for conciliation—

- (a) provisions requiring a copy of the application by which the proceedings are instituted, and a copy of any notice relating to it which is lodged by or on behalf of the person against whom the proceedings are brought, to be sent to the Agency,<sup>F2</sup> and]
- (b) provisions securing that the applicant and the person against whom the proceedings are brought are notified that the services of the Agency are available to them,<sup>F3</sup> . . .
