EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

MAIN ELEMENTS OF THE ORDER

- 7. The proposal to remove the 20-partner limit in partnerships aims to further encourage enterprise in Northern Ireland by removing a regulatory measure, which potentially inhibits the development of partnerships, and adds administrative and cost burdens to the operation of partnerships affected by the limit.
- 8. The proposals will also provide Northern Ireland partnerships with the same regulatory framework operating in Great Britain thus reducing any competitive advantage favouring GB firms.
