 - (b) a person (whether an individual or a body) undertaking to provide general ophthalmic services or pharmaceutical services under Part VI of that Order; or
 - (c) an individual performing personal medical services or personal dental services in accordance with arrangements made under Article 15B of that Order (except as employees of, or otherwise on behalf of, a health and [F3]social care] body or an independent provider).

 - (b) not being a health and [F4]social care] body or a general [F5]health care] provider.
