#### FIREARM CERTIFICATES – EXEMPTIONS

*Athletics meetings, etc.*

6. A person [<sup>F1</sup>who has attained the age of eighteen] may, without holding a firearm certificate, have a firearm in his possession at an athletics meeting or other competitive occasion for the purpose of starting, finishing or abandoning races.
