Teachers' Salaries and Allowances

REGULATIONS, DATED 20TH JUNE 1974, MADE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION AND LIBRARIES (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1972.

The Department of Education, in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Articles 57 and 125 of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(a) and by section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and after consultation with the Department of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Teachers' Salaries Amending Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1974, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st June 1974.

2. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1974(c).

3. In Regulation 3(2)(b) of the existing Regulations the words "and 35" shall be omitted, and for the words "Regulations 24 or 25" there shall be substituted the words "Regulations 24, 25 or 25A".

4. After Regulation 25 of the existing Regulations there shall be inserted the following Regulation—

"Cost of living allowance

25A.—(1) The following allowance, hereinafter referred to as the cost of living allowance, shall be payable to all full-time teachers to whom these Regulations apply in addition to salary as otherwise determined under these Regulations:

(a) The cost of living allowance shall be £62.64 per annum with effect from 1st June 1974; and

(b) during the period up to and including 15th November 1974, for each additional 1.85 points increase above 202.1 in the Retail Price Index figure as published by the Department of Employment, the cost of living allowance shall be increased by £20.88 per annum with effect from the first day of the month next following the date of publication of such Retail Price Index figure.

(2) The cost of living allowance, and any like allowance payable to any teacher as part of his remuneration for teaching service in an institution of further education or college of education, shall be disregarded for the purposes of determining the salary placing position of the teacher on any of the scales set out in these Regulations."

5. To paragraph (4)(b) of Regulation 35 of the existing Regulations there shall be added the following—

“, but for the purposes of paragraph (5) “salary” shall not include the cost of living allowance payable under Regulation 25A.”.

6. To paragraph (5) of Regulation 35 of the existing Regulations there shall be added the following—

“, provided however that the cost of living allowance payable under Regulation 25A shall be added to the rate of salary so determined, for the purpose of calculation of payment for each working day.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations provide for the payment of a cost of living allowance to full-time teachers in primary schools, secondary schools (other than technical intermediate schools) and special schools.
