SCHEME, DATED THE 28TH JUNE 1974, MADE BY THE HEAD OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 1 OF THE AGRICULTURE (TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1954 AS AMENDED BY THE AGRICULTURE (TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE) (AMENDMENT) ACT (Northern Ireland) 1957.

The Head of the Department of Agriculture with the approval of the Head of the Department of Finance and in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(a) as amended by the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland) 1957(b) and of all other powers him thereunto enabling hereby makes the following Scheme: -

Short title and commencement

- 1.—(1) This Scheme may be cited as the Beef Marketing Subsidy (Revocation) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1974.
 - (2) This Scheme shall come into operation on 1st July 1974.
