## CORONERS

**Coroners (Salaries) (No. 2) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1974**

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 26th August 1974  
*To be laid before Parliament*

RULES, DATED 19TH JULY 1974, MADE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE UNDER SECTION 36 OF THE CORONERS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1959 AND SECTION 18 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE AND FINANCIAL PROVISIONS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1962.

In pursuance of section 36(1)(a) of the Coroners Act (Northern Ireland) 1959(a) read with section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(b), I hereby make, after consultation with the Minister for the Civil Service(c), the following Rules:—

*Citation and commencement*

1.—(1) These Rules may be cited as the Coroners (Salaries) (No. 2) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1974.

(2) These Rules shall come into operation on 26th August 1974 and shall have effect as from 1st July 1974.

*Salaries of Coroners*

2. The annual salary payable to a Coroner appointed for a district set out in column 1 of the Schedule shall be the amount specified in column 2 and shall be inclusive of any travelling, subsistence, telephone and out-of-pocket expenses incurred by him in the course of his duty as Coroner.

*Salaries of Deputy Coroners*

3. The annual salary payable to a Deputy Coroner shall be one-twelfth the annual salary (determined in accordance with Rule 2) of the Coroner whose deputy he is, and shall be inclusive of any travelling, subsistence, telephone and out-of-pocket expenses incurred by him in the course of his duty as Deputy Coroner.

*Revocations*

4. Rules 2 and 3 of the Coroners (Salaries) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1974(d) are hereby revoked.
