### WAGES COUNCILS.

## Wages Regulation (Dressmaking and Women's Light Clothing)

ORDER, DATED 9TH AUGUST 1974, MADE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MAN-POWER SERVICES UNDER THE WAGES COUNCILS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1945.

The Department of Manpower Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 10 of the Wages Councils Act (Northern Ireland) 1945(a), hereby makes the following Order to give effect to wages regulation proposals received from the Dressmaking and Women's Light Clothing Wages Council (Northern Ireland):—

#### Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Dressmaking and Women's Light Clothing Wages Regulation (Amendment) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1974.

#### Commencement

2. The wages regulation proposals set out in the Schedule shall come into operation on the specified date and on the day immediately preceding that date the Dressmaking and Women's Light Clothing Wages Regulation (Amendment) (No. 6) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973(b) shall cease to have effect.

#### *Interpretation*

3. In this Order the expression "the specified date" means the 27th day of August 1974, provided that where, as respects any worker who is paid wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, that date does not correspond with the beginning of the period for which the wages are paid, the expression "the specified date" means, as respects that worker, the beginning of the next such period following that date.

# Statutory minimum remuneration for female workers employed in the retail bespoke branch of the trade

This Order, which comes into operation on 27th August 1974, amends the Dressmaking and Women's Light Clothing Wages Regulation (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1970 (Order N.I.W.D. (127)) as amended by the Dressmaking and Women's Light Clothing Wages Regulation (Amendment) (No. 6) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973 (Order N.I.W.D. (147)) by increasing the statutory minimum remuneration fixed by those Orders.

Order N.I.W.D. (147) is revoked.
