HOUSING ON FARMS

Housing on Farms (Grants) Order (Northern Ireland) 1974

To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974.

The Department of Housing, Local Government and Planning (in this Order referred to as "the Department") with the approval of the Department of Finance in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 11 of the Housing on Farms Act (Northern Ireland) 1972(a) (in this Order referred to as "the Act") and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Housing on Farms (Grants) Order (Northern Ireland) 1974 and shall come into operation on the 1st January 1975.

Interpretation

2. In this Order "approved cost" means in relation to any works such costs as the Department considers have been or will be reasonably and properly incurred in respect of those works.

Grants for provision of new farmhouses

3. The amount of grant payable under section 1 of the Act in respect of the provision of a new farmhouse completed between the 1st January 1975 and the 31st December 1975 inclusive in accordance with plans approved by the Department, and falling within the category mentioned in the first column of Schedule 1, shall be the amount specified in the second column of the said Schedule.

Grants for provision of houses for approved workers

4. The amount of grant payable under section 4 of the Act in respect of the provision of an approved worker's house completed between the 1st January 1975 and the 31st December 1975 inclusive in accordance with plans approved by the Department, and falling within the category mentioned in the first column of Schedule 2, shall be the amount specified in the second column of the said Schedule.

Grants for reconditioned premises as farmhouses or approved workers' houses

5. The amount of grant payable under section 7 of the Act in respect of the reconditioning of any premises for use as a farmhouse or approved worker's house completed before 1st January 1977 in accordance with

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plans approved by the Department between 1st January 1975 and the 31st December 1975 inclusive, and falling within the category mentioned in the first column of Schedule 3, shall be the amount specified in the second column of the said Schedule.

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EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order continues the existing rates of grant for the provision of new farmhouses and houses for approved workers which are completed during the year 1975.

The Order also continues the existing rates of grant in respect of schemes for the reconditioning of premises for use as houses on farms approved by the Department of Housing, Local Government and Planning during the year 1975 and prescribes the date before which the reconditioning works must be completed in order to qualify for the rates of grant specified.
