REGULATIONS, DATED 1ST MARCH 1974, MADE BY THE NATIONAL INSURANCE JOINT AUTHORITY, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE, UNDER THE NATIONAL INSURANCE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1966.

The National Insurance Joint Authority, in conjunction with the Department of Finance, in exercise of powers conferred by section 49(1) of the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(a), and in exercise of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following regulations being regulations subject to negative resolution in accordance with section 101(3) of that Act:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the National Insurance (Hospital In-Patients) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1974 and shall come into operation on 4th March 1974.

Amendment of the National Insurance (Hospital In-Patients) Regulations

2. In regulation 13(2)(b) of the National Insurance (Hospital In-Patients) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973(b) (calculation of periods) for the words "Article 36" there shall be substituted the words "Articles 15 and 36".
