Smoke Control Areas—Exempted Fireplaces

REGULATIONS, DATED 12TH MARCH 1974, MADE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT UNDER SECTION 11(7) OF THE CLEAN AIR ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1964.

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 11(7) of the Clean Air Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Smoke Control Areas (Exempted Fireplaces) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1974.

Exempted fireplaces

2. The classes of fireplace described in column (1) of the Schedule shall, subject to the conditions specified in column (2), be exempted from the provisions of section 11 of the Clean Air Act (Northern Ireland) 1964.

Conditions

The fireplace known as the Rayburn Prince 101 and manufactured by Glynwed Foundries Limited.

The fireplace known as the Rayburn Prince 301 and manufactured by Glynwed Foundries Limited.

The fireplaces shall be installed, maintained and operated so as to minimise the emission of smoke and in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. No fuel shall be used other than selected washed coal singles.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

Section 11 of the Clean Air Act (Northern Ireland) 1964 empowers district councils to declare the whole or any part of their district to be a smoke control area in which the emission of smoke is, generally, prohibited. These Regulations exempt the Rayburn Prince 101 fireplace and the Rayburn Prince 301 fireplace from the provisions of that section, upon certain conditions as to proper operation.
