ORDER, DATED 28TH MARCH 1974, MADE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE UNDER ARTICLE 3(4) OF THE SUPERANNUATION (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1972.

The Department of Finance in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Article 3(4) of the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Superannuation (Assembly Offices) Order (Northern Ireland) 1974 and shall come into operation on 29th March 1974.

2. There shall be removed from the offices listed in Schedule 1 to the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972 the following offices:—

3. There shall be added to the offices listed in Schedule 1 to the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972 after the words “Ulster Museum” the following offices:—

 Fourth Clerk at the Table
