Juries (Form of Medical Certificate) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975

Coming into operation . . . 11th August 1975

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State in pursuance of Articles 2(2), 6(3) and 7 of the Juries (Northern Ireland) Order 1974(a) hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

Made

1. These regulations may be cited as the Juries (Form of Medical Certificate) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975 and shall come into operation on 11th August 1975.

Form of medical certificate

2. For the purposes of Article 6(3) of the Juries (Northern Ireland) Order 1974 (which enables a person to be excused from jury service on the ground of ill health) a medical certificate shall be in accordance with the form set out in the Schedule.
