LOCAL GOVERNMENT**Local Government (Modifications and Repeals of Historic Monuments Legislation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976***Made* 26th March 1976*Coming into operation* 10th May 1976*To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974*

The Department(a) of Finance in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 134 of the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland) 1972(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Government (Modifications and Repeals of Historic Monuments Legislation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976 and shall come into operation on 10th May 1976.

2. The transferred provisions mentioned in columns 1 to 3 of the Schedule shall have effect subject to the modifications and repeals specified in column 4.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order modifies and repeals certain provisions in the Historic Monuments Act (Northern Ireland) 1971 in consequence of the abolition of county councils in the course of local government reorganisation.
