ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Restriction of Traffic (Ballyfore Road, Larne) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1976

Made 26th March 1976
Coming into operation 1st June 1976

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment for Northern Ireland is satisfied that the road described in Article 2(1) is unsuitable for use by certain classes of vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE the Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall be cited as the Restriction of Traffic (Ballyfore Road, Larne) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1976.

2.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) that part of Ballyfore Road, Larne (Unclassified Road No. 45) from its junction with Unclassified Road No. 44 in the townland of Ballynarry to its junction with the Larne-Carrickfergus Road, Route B100 in the townland of Tureagh, shall not be used by vehicles exceeding five tons in laden weight.

(2) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to the use of the said part of the road by vehicles exceeding five tons in laden weight where such vehicles are being used by the owners or occupiers of premises or lands abutting on or convenient to the said road or for the delivery to or collection from such premises or lands of goods of any kind, or in connection with public utility or emergency services.
