INSURANCE

Insurance Companies (Changes of Director, Controller or Manager) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976

Made 19th May 1976 Coming into operation 9th July 1976

The Department(a) of Commerce, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Articles 63(1)(a), 64(1)(a), 65(1) and 93 of the Insurance Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1976(b) (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Insurance Companies (Changes of Director, Controller or Manager) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976 and shall come into operation on 9th July 1976.

Application

2. These regulations apply to every insurance company to which Part III of the Order applies and are made for the purposes of Articles 63, 64 and 65 of the Order.

Particulars of proposed managing director or chief executive

3. A notice served on the Department of Commerce pursuant to Article 63(1)(a) of the Order shall, in relation to the managing director or chief executive proposed to be appointed by the insurance company, contain the particulars prescribed in Form A in the Schedule.

Particulars of person proposing to become controller

- 4. A notice served on the Department of Commerce pursuant to Article 64(1)(a) of the Order shall contain—
 - (a) where the person proposing to become a controller is an individual (not being a person in respect of whom particulars have been supplied under regulation 3), the particulars prescribed in Form B in the Schedule:
 - (b) where the person proposing to become a controller is a body corporate, the particulars prescribed in Form C in the Schedule.

Notification by person becoming or ceasing to be controller

5. A person who, pursuant to Article 65(1) of the Order, notifies an insurance company of the fact that he has become or has ceased to be a controller of that company shall at the same time notify the company in writing of the matters prescribed in Form D in the Schedule.

Notification by person becoming director

6. A person who becomes a director of an insurance company shall, within the period of seven days as specified in Article 65(1) of the Order, notify that company in writing of the matters prescribed in Form B in the Schedule.

Notification by person becoming manager

- 7.—(1) A person who becomes a manager of an insurance company shall, within a period of seven days as specified in Article 65(1) of the Order, notify that company in writing—
 - (a) where that person is an individual, of the matters prescribed in Form B in the Schedule;
 - (b) where that person is a body corporate, of the matters prescribed in Form C in the Schedule.
- (2) Each partner of a partnership which becomes a manager of an insurance company shall, within a period of seven days as specified in Article 65(1) of the Order, notify that company in writing—
 - (a) where the partner is an individual, of the matters prescribed in Form B in the Schedule;
 - (b) where the partner is a body corporate, of the matters prescribed in Form C in the Schedule.

These regulations prescribe the information which must be supplied to the Department of Commerce regarding any person proposing to become a controller of an insurance company to which Part III of the Insurance Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1976 applies and the information which must be supplied to an insurance company by any person becoming or ceasing to be a controller of the company or becoming a director or manager of the company.

The said Order was brought into operation on 19th April 1976 by virtue of the Insurance Companies (1976 Order) (Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976 (S.R. 1976 No. 56 (C. 2)).
