ROAD AND RAILWAY TRANSPORT

The Road Service Licensing (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976

Made 22nd June 1976 Coming into operation 1st September 1976

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 45(i) of the Transport Act (Northern Ireland) 1967(a), and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as "The Road Service Licensing (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976" and shall come into operation on 1st September 1976.

Amendment of licensing requirements

- 2. In Regulation 8(a) of the Road Service Licensing Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1968(c) after paragraph (iv) there shall be inserted the following paragraph:
 - "(v) the use of a motor vehicle having seating capacity for not more than six persons excluding the driver pursuant to an arrangement to carry children to or from school made under Article 41 of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(d) with an Education and Library Board within the meaning of that Order."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations extend the exemptions contained in the principal Regulations by exempting persons carrying children to and from school in motor vehicles as defined in these Regulations and by arrangement with Education and Library Boards from the Statutory requirement to obtain a Road Service Licence under Part II of the Transport Act (Northern Ireland) 1967.
