**Coroners (Salaries, Fees and Expenses) (Amendment) Rules
(Northern Ireland) 1976***Made* 26th July 1976*Coming into operation* 1st September 1976*To be laid before Parliament*

The Secretary of State(a), in pursuance of section 36(1)(a) of the Coroners Act (Northern Ireland) 1959(b) after consultation with the Minister for the Civil Service(c), hereby makes the following rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These rules may be cited as the Coroners (Salaries, Fees and Expenses) (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1976 and shall come into operation on 1 September 1976.

Amendment of the 1971 Rules

2. The provisions of Schedule 2 of the Coroners (Salaries, Fees and Expenses) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1971(d) shall be amended as follows:

- (a) in Part I paragraph 4 for the figures "2.8p" and "7p" there shall be substituted the figures "4.6p" and "9.4p" respectively;
- (b) in Part I paragraph 5 for the figure "1.5p" there shall be substituted the figure "2.2p"; and
- (c) in Part II paragraph 9(3)(ii) for the figure "£6.70" there shall be substituted the figure "£8.00".
