Coroners (Salaries, Fees and Expenses) (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1976

Made 26th July 1976

Coming into operation 1st September 1976

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State(a), in pursuance of section 36(1)(a) of the Coroners Act (Northern Ireland) 1959(b) after consultation with the Minister for the Civil Service(c), hereby makes the following rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These rules may be cited as the Coroners (Salaries, Fees and Expenses) (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1976 and shall come into operation on 1 September 1976.

Amendment of the 1971 Rules

- 2. The provisions of Schedule 2 of the Coroners (Salaries, Fees and Expenses) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1971(d) shall be amended as follows:
 - (a) in Part I paragraph 4 for the figures "2.8p" and "7p" there shall be substituted the figures "4.6p" and "9.4p" respectively;
 - (b) in Part I paragraph 5 for the figure "1.5p" there shall be substituted the figure "2.2p"; and
 - (c) in Part II paragraph 9(3)(ii) for the figure "£6.70" there shall be substituted the figure "£8.00".
