## Jurors (Payments) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976

Made . . . . . 2nd August 1976

Coming into operation . . . . . 1st September 1976

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State(a), in pursuance of section 1 of the Juries Act (Northern Ireland) 1953(b), after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice and with the approval of the Minister for the Civil Service(c), hereby makes the following Order:

*Citation and commencement*

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Jurors (Payments) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1976.

*Amendment of 1975 Order*

**2.** The schedule to the Jurors (Payments) Order (Northern Ireland) 1975(d) shall be amended as follows:

- (a) in paragraph 4, for the expressions "2.8p" and "7p" there shall be substituted the expressions "4.6p" and "9.4p" respectively;
- (b) in paragraph 5, for the expression "1.5p" there shall be substituted the expression "2.2p";
- (c) in paragraph 9(3), for the expression "£6.70" there shall be substituted the expression "£8.00"; and
- (d) in paragraph 9(4), for the expression "£13.40" there shall be substituted the expression "£16.00".
