Rates (Regional Rate and Reduction of Regional Rate on Dwelling-houses) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976*Made* 2nd February 1976*Coming into operation* 1st April 1976*To be laid before Parliament under Paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974.*

The Department(a) of Finance in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 7 and 27 of the Rates (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Rates (Regional Rate and Reduction of Regional Rate on Dwelling-houses) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1976.

Regional Rate

2. The regional rate for the year ending on 31st March 1977 shall be 48 pence in the pound.

Reduction of Rate on Dwellings

3. The amount in the pound by which the regional rate levied, in respect of dwelling-houses is to be reduced for the year ending on 31st March 1977 for the purpose of Article 27 of the Rates (N.I.) Order 1972 shall be 12 pence.
