# Police Cadets (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976

13th August 1976 Made

1st November 1976 Coming into operation

To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State(a), in pursuance of section 10 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(b), read with section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(c), and after consulting the Police Council for the United Kingdom and, in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act of 1970, the Police Authority for Northern Ireland and the Police Association for Northern Ireland, hereby, with the concurrence of the Minister for the Civil Service(d), makes the following regulations:

# Citation, commencement and effect

- 1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Police Cadets (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976.
- (2) These regulations shall come into operation on 1st November 1976 and shall have effect from 1st January 1976.

#### Allowances

- 2.—(1) In paragraph (1) of regulation 15 of the Police Cadets Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970(e) (which relates to travel allowances) for the reference to "£0.400" there shall be substituted a reference to "£0.50".
- (2) In paragraph (2) of the said regulation 15, for the reference to "£15" there shall be substituted a reference to "£36".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations, which have effect from 1st January 1976, amend the Police Cadets Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970.

Regulation 2(1) provides, in certain cases, for the payment of travel allowances in respect of return journeys costing more than 50p to visit a parent or guardian, and regulation 2(2) increases from £15 to £36 the maximum travel allowance for a cadet visiting his parent or guardian outside the British Isles.

Retrospection is authorised by section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962.
