Petty Sessions Times Order (Northern Ireland) 1976

Made 2nd September 1976 Coming into operation 1st November 1976 To be laid before Parliament

The Secretary of State(a) in pursuance of section 21(3)(a) of the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(b), after consultation with the County Court Judges and the Resident Magistrates referred to in that section, hereby makes the following rules:

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Petty Sessions Times Order (Northern Ireland) 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1976.

Times of holding Petty Sessions

- 2.—(1) The times when petty sessions shall be held regularly in or for the petty sessions districts set out in the first column of the Schedule shall be as set out in the second column of the Schedule opposite the name of the petty sessions district.
- (2) When the time fixed for the holding of petty sessions for a district would but for this paragraph be on Christmas Day or Good Friday, the time fixed for holding such petty sessions shall be the time fixed for the next following petty sessions for that district.

Revocation

3. The Petty Sessions Times Order (Northern Ireland) 1974(c) in so far as it relates to the times of the sittings of Ballycastle, Ballyclare, Ballymena, Ballymoney, Carrickfergus, Larne, Newtownabbey, Banbridge, Ballynahinch, Downpatrick, Dromore, Holywood, Newtownards, Magherafelt, Moneymore, Castlederg, Clogher, Cookstown, Dungannon, Pomeroy and Strabane petty sessions districts, is hereby revoked.
