Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976

Made 3rd November 1976

Coming into operation 29th November 1976

The Department(a) of Agriculture, on the recommendation of the Livestock Marketing Commission for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 4(1) of the Livestock Marketing Commission Act (Northern Ireland) 1967(b) as amended by the Livestock Marketing Commission (Maximum Levy) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976(c), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following regulations:

*Citation and commencement*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Livestock Marketing Commission (Levy) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976 and shall come into operation on 29th November 1976.

*Interpretation*

2. In these regulations—  
“Department” means the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland;  
“principal regulations” means the Livestock Marketing Commission (Levy) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1969(d).

*Amendment of the principal regulations*

3. The principal regulations are hereby amended as follows—

- (1) In paragraph (1) of Regulation 2 for 5/- and 2/6 there shall be substituted 45p and 25p respectively;
- (2) In paragraph (2) of Regulation 2 for 6d there shall be substituted 4p;
- (3) In paragraph (3) of Regulation 2 for 2/6 there shall be substituted 12½p;
- (4) In paragraph (4) of Regulation 2 for 1/6 there shall be substituted 7½p;
- (5) For the Schedule thereto there shall be substituted the Schedule.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)*

These regulations increase the rates of levy payable in respect of bovine animals and sheep. The levies for sows and boars remain unchanged. The new regulations do not change the procedures for collection of levies.

The old and new levies are as follows:—

	Old	New
Cattle (other than those shipped live to Great Britain)	25p	45p
Cattle sent to Great Britain	12½p	25p
Sheep	2½p	4p
Sows	12½p	12½p
Boars	7½p	7½p
