Coming into operation 15th November 1976

The Department of Health and Social Services(a) in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 98, 106 and 107 of, and Schedule 15 to, the Health and Personal Social Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Department of Finance(a), hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Charges for Drugs and Appliances (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976 and shall come into operation on 15th November 1976.

Amendment

2. In Regulation 15(1)(f)(ii) of the Health and Personal Social Services (Charges for Drugs and Appliances) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973(c) as amended(d) after "23(1A)" there shall be inserted "23(1B)".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations further amend the Health and Personal Social Services (Charges for Drugs and Appliances) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973 by increasing the amount by which earnings are to be disregarded for the purposes of calculating entitlement to an exemption from charges in the case of a parent in a one-parent family.
