Street Trading Licence Application Fee (Increase) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1976

Made 2nd December 1976

Coming into operation 1st January 1977

*To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of
Schedule 1 to Northern Ireland Act 1974*

The Department(a) of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1(1) of, and paragraph 5 of Schedule 1 to, the Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1968(b), and now vested in it(c), and of every other power enabling it on that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Street Trading Licence Application Fee (Increase) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1977.

Increase of Fee

2. The amount of the fee payable under section 3 of the Street Trading (Regulation) Act (Northern Ireland) 1929(d) by any person making application for the grant or renewal of a licence under that Act shall be increased from £1.00 to £5.00.
