**County Courts Times of Sittings (Londonderry Recorder's Court)
Order (Northern Ireland) 1976**

Made 20th December 1976

Coming into operation 1st January 1977

The Secretary of State(a) in pursuance of sections 2 and 4 of the County Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1959(b) hereby makes the following order:

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the County Courts Times of Sittings (Londonderry Recorder's Court) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1977.

Times of sittings and nature of business to be transacted

2. The ordinary sittings of the Londonderry Recorder's Court shall be held within the periods shown in the first column of the schedule and the nature of the business to be transacted by such court shall be as specified in the second column.

Revocation

3. So much of the Order in Council dated 27th July 1937(c) made under section 11 of the County Officers and Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1925(d) as relates to the Londonderry Recorder's Court is hereby revoked.

<i>Times of sittings</i>	<i>Nature of business to be transacted</i>
January/February/March August/September/October October/November/December	All criminal and civil business.
April/May/June/July	All criminal and civil business excluding original criminal proceedings.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This order fixes the periods within which the ordinary sittings of the Londonderry Recorder's Court are to be held and specifies the nature of the business to be transacted at those sittings.
