POLICE**Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Pensions)
(Amendment) Regulations 1976***Made* 23rd December 1976*Coming into operation* 14th February 1977*To be laid before Parliament*

The Secretary of State(a) in pursuance of section 26 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(b) and after consulting, in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act, the Police Authority for Northern Ireland and the Police Association for Northern Ireland, hereby with the concurrence of the Minister for the Civil Service(c) makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Pensions) (Amendment) Regulations 1976 and shall come into operation on 14th February 1977.

Assignment of awards

2. In regulation 12 of the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Pensions) Regulations 1973(d) after the reference to regulation 72 of the principal regulations there shall be inserted a reference to regulation 72A of the principal regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations amend the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve Pensions Regulations 1973.

The 1973 regulations provided for the application of certain provisions of the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions Regulations 1973 to members of the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve.

A recent amendment to the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions Regulations 1973 made by the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1976 (1976 S.R. No. 401) introduced provisions relating to assignment of an award granted under those regulations.

The present regulations provide for the application of those provisions to members of the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve.
